

## Release Plan

### WHO Drug Dictionary/ WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced

The dictionaries are produced on a quarterly basis. The data files and the corresponding documents are published on the release dates in the UMC Customer Area on the internet - <http://www.unc-products.com/customerarea>.

The same material is also available on CD. The CDs will be sent by mail on the release date.

The release dates are:

- March 1
- June 1
- September 1
- December 1

Notice that the versions of the WHO Drug Dictionary previously have been known as Quarter 1, Quarter 2, Quarter 3 and Quarter 4. The quarters referred to the period when the data was entered into the dictionary, not when it was distributed to the customers.

In the future we will refer to the releases with the names in the list above which refer to the date when the files are available for you at the UMC customer area website.

Quarter 1 (Q1)	June 1
Quarter 2 (Q2)	September 1
Quarter 3 (Q3)	December 1
Quarter 4 (Q4)	March 1

In case any of these dates are on a Saturday or a Sunday the release date will be the following Monday.

If any of these dates are on a national Swedish holiday the release date will be on the next working day.

Any deviations from the release dates listed above will be posted on the UMC web-site on December 1 in the preceding year.

### ***ATC revision.***

From 2006 the new version of the Anatomical Therapeutic Chemical classification (ATC) will be implemented in the March 1 release every year. Any changes to the previous version are listed in the Changes section.

## **WHO Herbal Dictionary**

The WHO Herbal Dictionary is produced twice per year. The data files and the corresponding documents are published on the release dates in the UMC Customer Area on the internet - <http://www.umc-products.com/customerarea>.

The same material is also available on CD. The CDs will be sent by mail on the release date.

The release dates are:

- March 1
- September 1

In case any of these dates are on a Saturday or a Sunday the release date will be the following Monday.

If any of these dates are on a national Swedish holiday the release date will be on the next working day.

Any deviations from the release dates listed above will be posted on the UMC web-site on December 1 in the preceding year.

### ***ATC revision.***

The new version of the Herbal Anatomical Therapeutic Chemical classification (H-ATC) will be implemented in the March 1 release every year. Any changes to the previous version are listed in the Changes section.

### ***Combined WHO Herbal Dictionary and WHO Drug Dictionary/WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced***

It is possible to subscribe to the WHO Herbal Dictionary separately or combined with the WHO Drug Dictionary or the WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced. These combined dictionaries are available on the same dates as the WHO Herbal Dictionary:

- March 1
- September 1

### ***Subscriptions***

- If you subscribe to the WHO Herbal Dictionary or the combined dictionaries for only once per year you will receive the March 1 version.
- If you subscribe for two versions per year you will receive the March 1 and the September 1 versions.
- If you subscribe to a combination of WHO Herbal Dictionary and WHO Drug Dictionary/WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced and you subscribe for four versions of the WHO Drug Dictionary/WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced per year you will receive the combined dictionaries as above. The remaining two dates – June 1 and December 1 – you will receive the regular WHO Drug Dictionary or WHO Drug Dictionary Enhanced.

## Renewals and Invoicing

The UMC will automatically extend your subscription unless you actively ask us to discontinue according to the Licence agreement clause 9. The subscription is renewed on a yearly basis, and you will be informed 60 days in advance that your subscription will expire and will be renewed automatically. The renewal notice will be followed by an invoice 30 days after the renewal acknowledgement.

2005 will be the last year for 'moving annual invoicing'; in 2006 UMC Products & Services will change to calendar invoicing. All customers will have a subscription period from January 1 to December 31.

Moving annual invoicing. As a subscriber you have one of the alternatives below.  
Renewal and Invoicing dates 2005:

- Renewal information sent to customers on 1st of December 2004
- Invoice sent to customers 1st of January 2005
- The subscription will be valid from the March 1 release (previously known as Quarter 4)
  
- Renewal information 1st of March 2005
- Invoice 1st of April 2005
- The subscription will be valid from the June 1 release (previously known as Q 1)
  
- Renewal information 1st of June 2005
- Invoice 1st of July 2005
- The subscription will be valid from the September 1 release (previously known as Q 2)
  
- Renewal information 1st September 2005
- Invoice 1st of October 2005
- The subscription will be valid from the December 1 release (previously known as Q 3)

Renewal and Invoicing dates 2005, in order to synchronise to calendar invoicing:

- Renewal information September 12th 2005
- Invoice November 11th 2005
- Invoice due date January 13 2006

### From 2006

Renewal and Invoicing dates from 2006:

- Renewal information September 12th
- Invoice November 11th
- Invoice due date January 13
- The subscription will be valid from the March 1 release.

If you start your subscription in 2005 you will be invoiced for a full year and your subscription will be synchronised with calendar invoicing from 2007.
